ARROW EXTERMINATORS PUTS THE BRAKES ON DISTRACTED DRIVING

tlanta, Ga.-based Arrow
Exterminators focuses on reducing distracted driving by partnering with California, Md.-based InSight Mobile Data to launch a new safety program. Since implementing InSight's Complete Fleet Safety Program in early 2018, the multi-state pest management company has experienced significant reductions in "at-fault" collisions and vehicle maintenance spend.

Arrow began by rolling out Insight's software platform StreetEagle in a select number of vehicles, with the goal to have at least one vehicle equipped with a telematics device across its 115 service centers.

Arrow selected drivers for the deployment program who met the following criteria:

- 1) experienced an "at-fault" crash in previous 12 months;
- 2) received a validated bad-driver complaint from the community;
- 3) identifies as needing coaching and additional training; or
- 4) is new to the team and has a high-risk motor vehicle report (MVR).

Over the last 12 months, Arrow had 165 at-fault collisions. Of those, only 12 were drivers with an installed global positioning satellite (GPS) unit. The company also implemented a five-week rolling Driver Behavior GPS Policy, while monitoring and providing feedback on performance with InSight's fleet risk reporting.



Arrow's goal is to have all drivers' safety score below Insight's fleet risk reporting threshold score of 0.75, which is deemed risk-free.

"Arrow has seen a marked reduction in vehicle collisions by utilizing InSight's Fleet Safety Program, which assists our team in identifying high-risk drivers," says Brent Purcell, senior vice president of risk management for Arrow. "The in-cab alerting allows drivers to understand their risky behaviors and take corrective measures to stay more focused on the task at hand: driving safely."


